- Shotgun start at 7:00 am (Central time) from New Buffalo, St Joseph, Michigan City, and Portage harbors. (NO lines in the water prior to 7:00 am-Central time the day of the tournament).
- All boats must be inside the pier heads by 1:00 pm (Central time) or be disqualified.
- Any number of crew members can be on board; just don't overload the boat. A maximum of 12 rods can be used.
- All youth entrants must be between the ages of 5 and 16 years of age. You may have as many youths aboard as is safe for your boat.
- Anyone on the boat can set lines and net fish. When a fish bites anyone is allowed to remove the rod form the rod holder and give it to the youth <u>but youth(s) must be the only one(s)</u> to fight the fish and bring it boat side where it can be netted by any crew member.
- D More than one youth may participate in catching the same fish, but only one youth can enter that fish.
- All contestants must be registered and fish from a boat. Boats will not be provided.
- All boats must be at least 18' long and be equipped with a marine radio.
- No radio restrictions for this tournament.
- Weight-in will start at 2:00 pm (Central time) on Saturday June 15, 2019. Weigh ins take place at the Yacht Club in Michigan City and all coolers must be at the weigh-in location at that time. <u>All Times listed are Central Time.</u>
- There will be awards for largest fish based on weight. Each youth may only enter one fish and may not transfer any fish he/she caught to another contestant.
- If youths share a weight-in cooler, each youth shall mark their one fish in some manner to avoid confusion.
- No extra fish in coolers at weigh-in.
- The number of entries will determine total number of prizes. In the event of a tie, the position money will be added together and split.
- A trophy will be awarded to the largest fish overall determined by weight.
- If the tournament cannot begin by 9:00am(Central time), it will be cancelled. A three hour minimum fishing time is required to complete the tournament.
- All DNR rules apply.
- Entries must be paid by CASH or CHECK (payable to Hoosier Coho Club).
- REMEMBER this is a youth tournament. Have fun, teach sportsmanship and play by the rules. You are shaping our future. Rules will be discussed at the Captains meeting.
- RAIN DATE If the tournament is cancelled due to weather, it will take place the following day on June 16, 2019. Cancellation will be announced by 9am (Central time).
