## **Official Tournament Rules & Registration**

- Registration will be held from 6:00 to 6:45am at the Pavilion behind the Yacht Club in Michigan City. You may also coordinate your registration with the Coho Club prior to the tournament.
- Shotgun start at 7:00 am (Central time) from New Buffalo, St Joseph, Michigan City, Portage and East Chicago harbors.
- Any number of crew members can be on board, just don't overload the boat. A maximum of 12 rods can be used.
- All youth entrants must be between 5 and 16 years of age. You may have as many youths aboard as is safe for your boat.
- Anyone on the boat may set lines and net fish. The youth will be the only one to fight the fish.
- More than one youth may participate in catching the same fish, but only one youth may enter that fish.
- All contestants must be registered and fish from a boat. Boats will not be provided.
- All boats must be at least 18' long and be equipped with a marine radio. The tournament channel will be 68.
- Please be in line for weigh-in by 2:00 p.m. Weigh-in will take place at the Pavilion behind the Yacht Club in Michigan City and all coolers must be at the weigh-in location at that time. ALL TIMES ARE CENTRAL TIME!
- There will be awards for largest fish based on weight. Each youth may only enter one fish and may not transfer any fish he/she caught to another contestant.
- Solution: If youths share a weigh-in cooler, each youth shall mark their <u>one fish</u> in some manner to avoid confusion.
- No extra fish in coolers at weigh-in.
- The number of entries will determine the total number of prizes. In the event of a tie, prize money will be added and split.
- A trophy will be awarded to the largest fish overall determined by weight.
- If the tournament cannot begin by 9:00am(Central time), it will be cancelled.
- All DNR rules apply.
- Entries must be paid by CASH or CHECK (payable to Hoosier Coho Club) at registration.
- REMEMBER this is a youth tournament. Have fun, teach sportsmanship and play by the rules. You are shaping our future.
- RAIN DATE If the tournament is cancelled due to weather, it will take place the following day on August 14, 2022. Cancellation will be announced by 9am (Central time).
